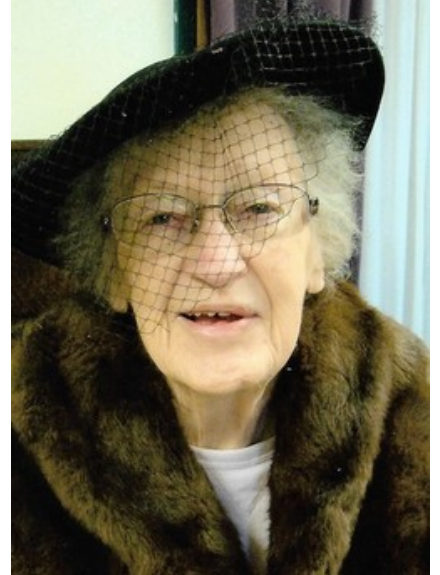
Mrs. Jennings was a housewife, former resident of Dexter and currently residing in Arnold, Missouri.
