Henry S. McCarty, son of the late George McCarty and Dora Webb McCarty was born on January 22, 1920 in Fornfelt, Missouri and departed this life on December 12, 2013 at the Saint Francis Medical Center in Cape Girardeau, Missouri at the age of 93 years.

Mr. McCarty was a Veteran of the United States Army serving in World War II, employed with the United States Postal Service as a Postal Clerk for many years, member of the American Legion, V.F.W., and Masonic Lodge in Dexter. He was also a member of the First Baptist Church in Dexter, and was a resident of Dexter.

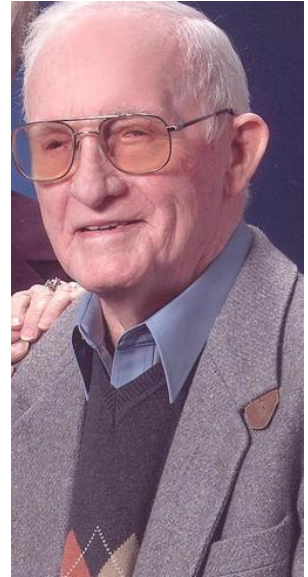
On April 19, 1943 he was united in marriage to Vivian L. Taylor. Mrs. McCarty survives of their home.
