Mrs. Nix survives of the home.

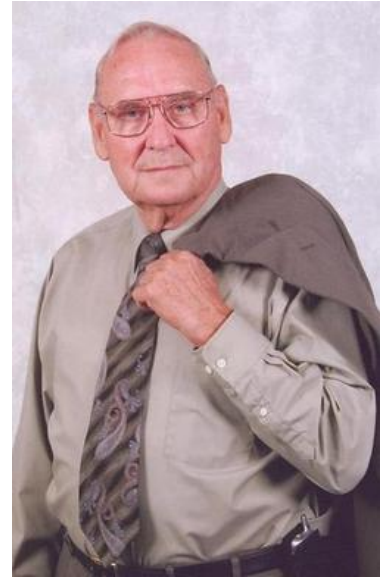
