Mr. Evans preceded her in death on April 29, 2000.

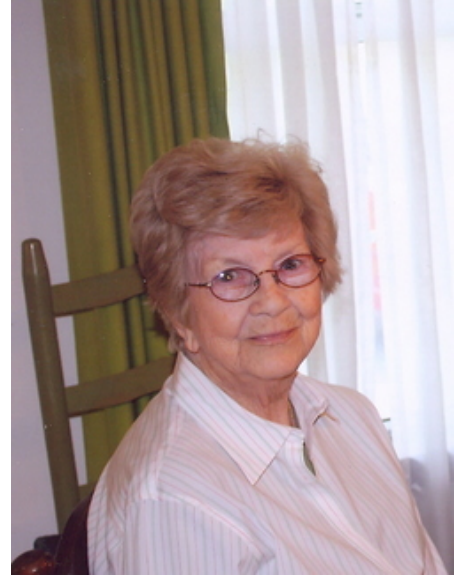
