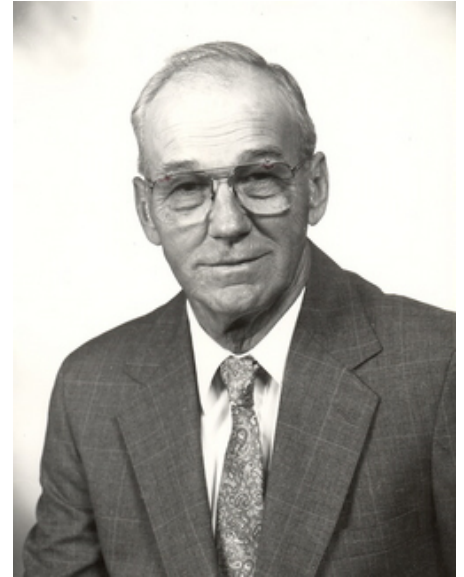
Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by one brother, J. W. Silliman.
