

Charles Hudson Long

August 29, 1922 - July 10, 2011

Charles H. Long, son of the late Ralph Long and Bertha Penniger Long was born on August 29, 1922 near Bloomfield, Missouri and departed this life in the Cypress Point Skilled Nursing Center in Dexter on July 10, 2011 at the age of 88 years.

Mr. Long was a self-employed Farmer for many years, retired after 23 years from the United States Post Office as a Mail Carrier in Bloomfield, Missouri; Veteran of the United States Army, member of the First General Baptist Church in Bloomfield, and a resident of Dexter, Missouri.

On August 20, 1944 he was united in marriage to Geraldine B. Wilson in Piggott, Arkansas.

Mrs. Long survives of the home in Dexter.
