Charles Fowler, son of the late James Robert and Pearl Cecil Fowler was born on October 6, 1924 in Risco, Missouri and departed this life on August 1, 2009 at the Missouri Delta Medical Center in Sikeston at the age of 84.

Mr. Fowler was a member of the Dexter Church of Christ. He was a Veteran of the United States Army serving with the Ozark Division of the 102nd infantry in Germany during World War 2.

He was wounded in December of 1944 and was awarded the Purple Heart for his injury and dedicated service to his Country.

He was a farmer, Board member of the Stoddard County drainage districts for many years, a member of the Advisory Board of Stoddard County Conservation Department and attended the Veterans Tour of Washington, D.C. in 2007.

On June 14, 1945 he was united in marriage to Evelyn Westmorlan in Kennett, Missouri.

Mrs. Fowler survives of their home in Essex.
