Dale Jones, son of the late Albert Jones and Dorothy Atchison Young was born on January 8, 1941 in Cape Girardeau, Missouri and departed this life on July 21, 2016 at the Saint Francis Medical Center in Cape Girardeau at the age of 75.

Mr. Jones was a Veteran of the United States Army, serving in Vietnam. During his service in the Army he served under the Special Forces in the Green Beret unit. Mr. Jones was a self-employed car dealer and a resident of Dexter. He and his wife attended the First Assembly of God Church in Dexter. Mr. Jones will be remembered as a loving husband, father and grandfather who could light up the room with laughter as soon as he entered. He was a Patriot who loved his God, his family and people.
