Mrs. Schmittzehe survives of the home in Dexter.

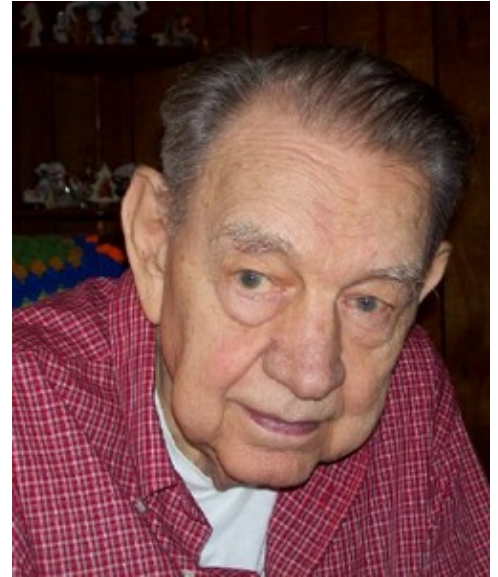
Besides his wife, he is survived by one sister, Meryl Elizabeth Weir of Hermann, Missouri.
