She is survived by two sons, Gary Clark

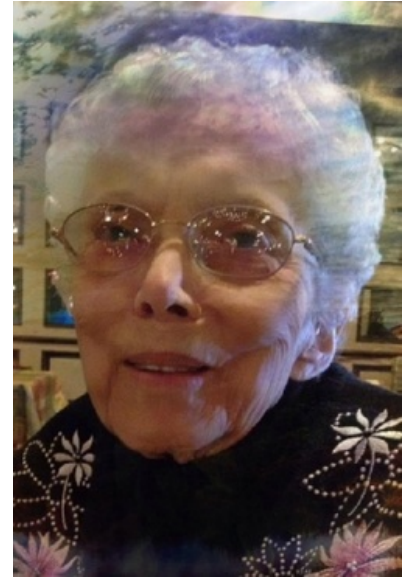
