Evelyn King Morse, daughter of the late Izadore King and Katie Bell King was born on July 13, 1922 in Mount Vernon, Illinois and departed this life on May 31, 2010 at her residence in Bloomfield, Missouri at the age of 87 years.

Mrs. Morse was raised in Campbell, Missouri where she graduated from Campbell High School in 1940.

Formally of Poplar Bluff, Missouri she worked for 25 years at Florsheim Shoe in Poplar Bluff and 12 years for the Conservation Department.

Evelyn was a member of the Memorial Baptist Church in Poplar Bluff, she loved all sports, and was a devoted grandmother, and great-grandmother.
