

Harold Oscar Watson

February 5, 1918 - April 24, 2009

Harold Watson, son of the late Felix and Iva Elliott Watson was born on February 5, 1918 in Kennett, Missouri and departed this life on April 24, 2009 in the Veterans Hospital at Poplar Bluff, Missouri at the age of 91.

Mr. Watson was a Veteran of the United States Regular Army serving in WW2.

He was a member of the Bernie United Methodist Church, a member of the Dexter Elks Lodge #2439 and a resident of Bernie.
