Mr. Lykins was employed by Tyson Foods, Inc. in Dexter.

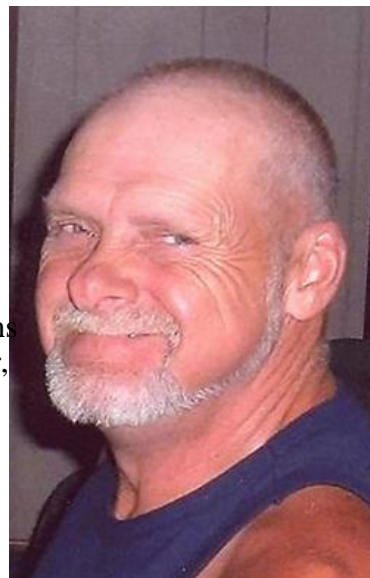
