John Bader, son of the late Marcus Bader and Margaret Stuever Bader was born on September 21, 1946 in Poplar Bluff, Missouri and departed this life on July 30, 2010 at his residence in rural Bloomfield, Missouri at the age of 63 years.

Mr. Bader was a former employee of Trinity Marine Products in Caruthersville, Missouri, member of the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Dexter, and a veteran of the United States Army serving in the Vietnam War.

On June 15, 1968 he was united in marriage to Jacquelynn Anne Coakley in Aurora, Illinois.

Mrs. Bader survives of the home in rural Bloomfield.
