Larry Schrick, son of the late John Schrick and Anna Putthoff Schrick was born on August 27, 1915 in Nortonville, Kansas and departed this life on Sunday August 7, 2011 at the Missouri Veterans Home in Cape Girardeau, Missouri at the age of 95 years.

Mr. Schrick owned and operated Schrick's Texaco for many years, a veteran of the United States Army serving in WWII, member of the St. Rose Philippine Duchesne Church in Florissant, Missouri, and a former resident of Florissant, Missouri currently living in Cape Girardeau, Missouri.

Survivors include one son, Thomas Schrick of O'Fallon, Missouri; by two daughters, Constance Butler of Eureka, Missouri and Kathryn Sansone of Florissant, Missouri; by one brother John Schrick of Kansas City, Missouri; two sisters, Louise Silvius of Shawnee Mission, Kansas and Margaret Diebold of Effingham, Kansas; also by eleven grandchildren and fifteen great-grandchildren.
