Leonard D. Carwile, son of the late James Carwile and Daisy Duffie Carwile was born on September 20, 1930 in Dexter, Missouri and departed this life at the Missouri Southern Healthcare in Dexter on January 12, 2011 at the age of 80.

Mr. Carwile was a former employee of General Mills in West Chicago, Illinois, veteran of the United States Army serving in Korean Conflict, and a resident of Dexter.
