Mr. Moore preceded her in death on April 1, 1996.

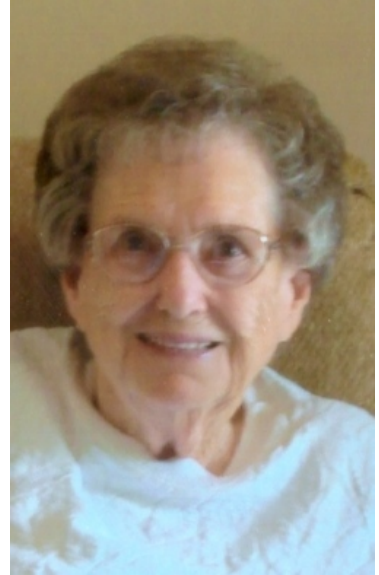
