Survivors include two sons, Kerry Williamson of Bloomfield and Kevin Williamson of Youngstown, Ohio;

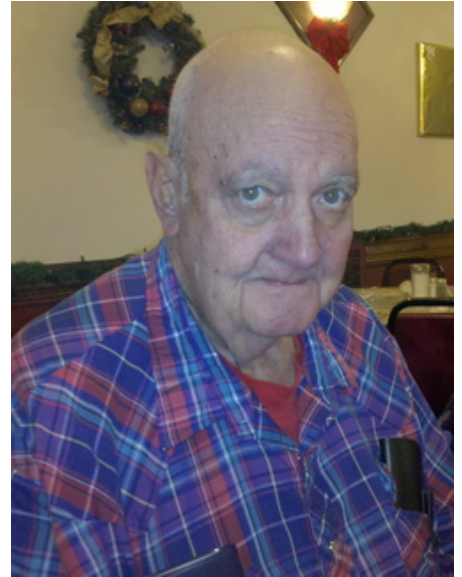
