July 3, 1924 - October 1, 2010

Rev. James J. Davis, son of the late James Davis and Eva Maggie Wiseman Davis was born on July 3, 1924 in Gideon, Missouri and passed away on Friday October 1, 2010 at the Missouri Southern Healthcare in Dexter, Missouri at the age of 86 years.

Mr. Davis was a retired Methodist Minister of 26 years in Southeast Missouri, member of the Grace United Methodist Church in Poplar Bluff, Missouri, Veteran of the United State Air Force, and a resident of Bloomfield, Missouri.

On July 27, 1950 he was united in marriage to Helen Eaton in Piggott, Arkansas. Mrs. Davis survives of the home in Bloomfield.
